

## Finding a COVID-19 Vaccine in Bucks County

The following is a partial list of possible sites to register and/or obtain an appointment for a COVID-19 vaccine in this extended area. Any additions would be welcome.

### Bucks County

This takes you directly to the page on which you can create, revise or cancel the preregistration form. Note that Bucks Co. is updating previous preregistration forms and email addresses, but this does not change your place in line for a vaccine appointment. Bucks Co. is currently administering vaccines at 3 Bucks County Community College campuses and expects to expand to more sites: the former Neshaminy Mall H&M and St. Luke's Quakertown on March 16.

### Bucks County Area Agency on Aging (AAA)

AAA can help seniors age 60 and above schedule appointments for a COVID-19 vaccine and arrange transportation, if needed. The phone number for Bucks Co. AAA is 267-880-5700, Mon. – Fri., 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

Enter ZIP code and hit "Go". Site lists providers in the area and how long-ago appointments were found.

### Vaccine Finder

Enter ZIP code; then enter "Within" how many miles; then click on "Search for Vaccine".

Enter county; site lists vaccine providers by availability and indicates how recently information was updated.

## Vaxxmax

Vaxxmax.com

Checks on RiteAid (and possibly Walgreens) and updates every 5 minutes. Enter the state; then click on the link <https://riteaid.com/pharmacy/apt-scheduler> which takes you to the RiteAid COVID-19 Vaccine Scheduler

## Apple Maps

Apple displays on Apple Maps places where users can get COVID-19 vaccine. Apple product users can search for a nearby site by asking Siri or typing in the search bar within Maps.

## Pharmacies

### Rite Aid

[www.riteaid.com](http://www.riteaid.com) (or [vaxxmax.com](http://vaxxmax.com) as noted above)

Find “Vaccine Information”, then “Schedule and Check Eligibility”; scroll down to Pennsylvania and in the far-right column find “Schedule Here”. New appointments are released between 11:45 PM and 12:15 AM.

CVS – the CVS website does not list any in this area, but the above noted sites do list several; availability is difficult. New appointments are released at 6 AM.

### ShopRite

Wegman’s – new appointments reportedly released mid-day or Friday afternoons.

Other chain and private pharmacies are listed in the various sites above.

### Healthgrades.com

### VAX

As per an article in the Intelligencer on 3/25/21, VAX is a service that looks for vaccine appointments in PA, NJ and NY. Use your phone to text to 912-361-6763 and provide your ZIP

code. VAX will message information to you about an available appointment in your area. Be ready to respond quickly once you receive a message.

All of these sites have limitations, and none of them can guarantee a timely appointment for a vaccine.
