

Volunteer Job Title: Children's Music Ensemble Chaperone

Reports To: Jason Moore (Director of Music and the Arts) for children's ensembles and Mina Choi (Director of Youth Music) for youth ensembles

Time Commitment: During weekly rehearsals (Wednesdays or Sundays) during the program year (September through May), as well as when participants ring or sing during a service.

Purpose: The purpose of this role is to support DPC's music ministry by providing classroom management and supervision assistance for children and youth music ensembles.

Duties: Chaperones are responsible for helping to ensure a safe and orderly environment for children/youth ensemble rehearsals. Primary duties include:

- Helping children/youth remain focused on ensemble activities and redirecting distracting behavior
- Escorting children to and from the restroom, when necessary
- Checking children/youth in and out of rehearsals (including ensuring participants are released to authorized parents/guardians)
- On the days in which an ensemble is participating in services, helping ensemble members with robes and props, as well as sitting with the children/youth at the front of the sanctuary to supervise

Requirements and Training:

- This role is open to any individual 18 years of age or older and a member of DPC, but is typically filled by parents, grandparents, or caregivers of children currently in the ensembles.
- All children/youth music ensemble chaperones must complete Doylestown Presbyterian Church's Community Protection Program (CPP) certification process, including an application, background checks, and a brief training. CPP certification is valid for five years.
