Volunteer Job Title: Sanctuary Decorator for Christmas

Reports To: Mark Strasburg, Moderator of the Worship, Music and Arts Committee

Time Commitment: Decorating of the sanctuary for the Christmas season occurs the week prior to the start of Advent. Volunteers are free to come and go as needed on the day(s) set aside for decorating.

Purpose: Through the adornment of the sanctuary and adjoining spaces, the purpose of this role is to prepare the sanctuary for the celebration of the Christmas season.

Duties: DPC has an assortment of Christmas decorations (e.g., artificial tree; wreaths; garland; nativity scenes) that are reused on an annual basis. Representatives of the Worship, Music, and Arts Committee provide all necessary direction to volunteers. While there are some tasks associated with decorating the sanctuary that require heavy lifting or climbing ladders, volunteers are free to decide if they wish to help with those more physical tasks. Volunteers in this role may be involved in such duties as retrieving decorations and supplies from storage spaces, unpacking boxes, assembling, erecting and securing the artificial Christmas tree, hanging crimson ornaments on the tree, and hanging wreaths and garland, among other tasks.

Requirements and Training:

- Participation is open to all.
- There is always a need for those able to perform such physical tasks as climbing ladders, lifting boxes, and setting up a large artificial Christmas tree.
- No specific training is required, and volunteers will be provided with direction on the day of the event.
