

Volunteer Job Title: Youth Sunday School Teacher (6th through 8th grade)

Reports To: Becca Bateman, Associate Pastor for Education and Family Ministries

Time Commitment: One to two hours per week (including prep time) on assigned weeks

- Youth Sunday school occurs on a weekly basis from 9:30-10:15am, September through May, except holidays that fall on a Sunday. Volunteers work in pairs or teams to rotate responsibilities
- In order to maintain consistency, youth Sunday school teachers are asked to fulfill a one-year term but are encouraged to serve for longer.

Purpose: To help youth develop a relationship with Jesus Christ, while serving as a consistent presence and welcoming each participant to the love of Doylestown Presbyterian Church.

Duties: Youth Sunday school teachers are responsible for the following:

- Preparing lessons and being prepared to teach on assigned weeks
- Arriving in the classroom at least 15 minutes prior to the start of class to ensure set-up is complete before the first child arrives and to welcome each participant as they arrive
- Learning the name of each participating youth and taking weekly attendance
- Regularly praying for the children in their care
- Working with other teachers to combine classrooms should the number of participants be small or if there are fewer teachers than needed to run separate classes safely and effectively

Requirements and Training:

- All youth Sunday school teachers must go through Doylestown Presbyterian Church's Community Protection Program (CPP) certification process, including an application, background checks, and a brief training. CPP certification is valid for five years.
- We seek volunteers able to share God's Word with youth in ways they can understand, apply to their lives, and express to others.
