**Volunteer Job Title:** Youth Sunday School Teacher (6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade)

**Reports To:** Becca Bateman, Associate Pastor for Education and Family Ministries

**Time Commitment:** One to two hours per week (including prep time) on assigned weeks

- Youth Sunday school occurs on a weekly basis from 9:30-10:15am, September through May, except holidays that fall on a Sunday. Volunteers work in pairs or teams to rotate responsibilities
- In order to maintain consistency, youth Sunday school teachers are asked to fulfill a one-year term but are encouraged to serve for longer.

**Purpose:** To help youth develop a relationship with Jesus Christ, while serving as a consistent presence and welcoming each participant to the love of Doylestown Presbyterian Church.

**Duties:** Youth Sunday school teachers are responsible for the following:

- Preparing lessons and being prepared to teach on assigned weeks
- Arriving in the classroom at least 15 minutes prior to the start of class to ensure set-up is complete before the first child arrives and to welcome each participant as they arrive
- Learning the name of each participating youth and taking weekly attendance
- Regularly praying for the children in their care
- Working with other teachers to combine classrooms should the number of participants be small or if there are fewer teachers than needed to run separate classes safely and effectively

**Requirements and Training:**

- All youth Sunday school teachers must go through Doylestown Presbyterian Church's Community Protection Program (CPP) certification process, including an application, background checks, and a brief training. CPP certification is valid for five years.
- We seek volunteers able to share God's Word with youth in ways they can understand, apply to their lives, and express to others.
