Volunteer Job Title: Children's Worship Time Plus (CWT+) Volunteer

Reports To: Becca Bateman, Associate Pastor for Education and Family Ministries

Time Commitment: Children's Worship Time Plus occurs during the worship service (second service only, during the program year), and lasts 25 to 40 minutes. Frequency of volunteering is at the discretion of the volunteer.

Purpose: The purpose of this role is to help provide a developmentally appropriate faith formation alternative to the traditional worship service for children in 4th through 6th grade.

Duties: CWT+ volunteers are responsible for the following:

- Following the children's message, escorting participating children from the sanctuary, across our enclosed bridge walkway, to the CWT+ classroom in Andrews Hall.
- Implementing the CWT+ curriculum, encouraging children's participation in lessons and activities, and helping to ensure a safe, welcoming, and enjoyable environment.
- Following CWT+, escorting children back to the sanctuary during the final hymn (or prior to Communion or Baptism, if either is taking place), and ensuring they rejoin their families/caregivers. On some occasions, parents may be asked to pick up their children in the CWT+ classroom at the conclusion of the worship service.

Requirements and Training:

- We seek volunteers who are interested in supporting the faith formation of children
- All CWT+ volunteers must go through Doylestown Presbyterian Church's Community Protection Program (CPP) certification process, including an application, background checks, and a brief training. CPP certification is valid for five years.
