Volunteer Job Title: Connections and Outreach Subcommittee Member

Reports To: Erin Rizk, Moderator

Time Commitment:

- Meetings are scheduled on an as-needed basis.
- In addition to meetings, subcommittee members have some duties to carry out that are aligned with the mission of the subcommittee.
- New subcommittee members generally begin in June, though they can also join the subcommittee at other times of year, at the discretion of the Moderator.

Purpose: The purpose of this role is to support the subcommittee as it works to identify resources and/or methods to form and strengthen interpersonal connections within DPC, as well as connections with the larger community.

Duties: Members of the Connections and Outreach Subcommittee are charged with assessing how DPC can more effectively reach and engage visitors, church members, and members of the surrounding community, as well as implementing related action steps. Some of the issues that subcommittee members are asked to consider include how to welcome a variety of people with diverse perspectives; how to help people in our community of faith connect in a multitude of ways and where that might occur (e.g., worship; Christian education and faith formation; special events; etc.); how ministries and committees welcome and include newcomers; and what actions can be taken to increase awareness of DPC in the greater community and to attract people to the church.

Requirements and Training:

- We seek to have subcommittee members who represent a variety of perspectives, including those related to tenure at the church, age/generation, gender, areas of involvement at DPC, and other factors.
- We seek subcommittee members who are constructive, energetic, personable, able to think holistically, and open to thinking outside of the box.
