

Volunteer Job Title: Growth Group Facilitator

Reports To: Kieran Cody, Moderator of the Adult Education Subcommittee

Time Commitment:

- Growth groups can be offered on a seasonal basis, with sessions lasting six to eight weeks, or on an ongoing basis.
- In addition to being present at each growth group gathering, facilitators can expect to spend time preparing for meetings.

Purpose: The purpose of this role is to support faith formation and the development of interpersonal connections among a small group of adult participants through gatherings focused on a specific theme or topic.

Duties: A growth group facilitator is responsible for the following:

- Selecting the group's topic/theme and reading material(s)
- Preparing for weekly meetings
- Effectively communicating changes in meeting schedule, location, or assignments with growth group participants
- Facilitating group discussions
- Coordinating with the Growth Group Coordinator and office staff around class schedule, publicity, room reservations, materials (if any), and schedule changes/cancelations.

Requirements and Training:

- This role is open to anyone with an interest in helping adults to grow in faith and form deeper relationships with Christ and one another.
- No specific training is required for this role.
