

Privacy Statement
Doylestown Presbyterian Church

Doylestown Presbyterian Church (“DPC,” “we,” “our,” or “us”) is committed to safeguarding the privacy and personal information of all individuals who interact with our ministry, programs, website, and services. This Privacy Statement sets forth the policies and practices with respect to the collection, use, disclosure, and protection of personal information provided to or collected by DPC.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect personal information through various means, including but not limited to: online forms, registrations, donations, email communications, volunteer sign-ups, and other interactions with DPC. The types of personal information we may collect include:

- Name, address, email address, and telephone number
- Demographic information such as age, gender, or family status
- Participation in church events, programs, or ministries
- Communications preferences and interactions

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 13 without verifiable parental consent, in accordance with applicable law.

2. Use of Information

DPC may use the personal information collected for the following purposes:

- To administer programs, services, and ministries
- To communicate with members, participants, and visitors
- To maintain accurate giving records
- To inform you of church-related news, events, and updates
- To comply with legal obligations and safeguard our community
- For internal administrative and recordkeeping purposes

We do not sell, rent, or trade personal information to third parties for marketing purposes.

3. Disclosure of Information

We may disclose personal information:

- When required by law or pursuant to legal process (e.g., subpoenas, court orders)
- To protect the safety, rights, or property of DPC, its members, or the public
- With your express consent or at your direction

4. Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect the confidentiality and integrity of personal information under our control. While we strive to protect personal data, no method of transmission over the internet or method of electronic storage is completely secure.

5. Third-Party Links

Our website or communications may contain links to external websites. DPC is not responsible for the privacy practices or content of such third-party sites. Users are encouraged to review the privacy policies of those sites before providing personal information.

6. Your Choices and Rights

You may request to review, update, or delete your personal information by contacting the church office. We will take reasonable steps to comply with such requests in accordance with applicable laws and church policies.

You may also opt out of receiving non-essential communications from us by using the unsubscribe link in emails or by contacting us directly.

7. Changes to This Privacy Statement

DPC reserves the right to modify or update this Privacy Statement at any time. Any changes will become effective upon posting to our website, unless otherwise required by law.

Continued use of our services or website following such changes constitutes your acceptance of the revised policy.
